

Rainmaker

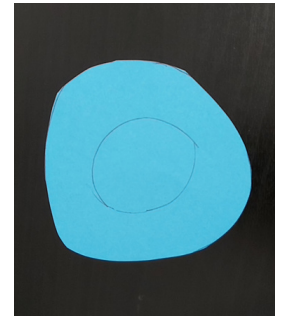
What you need:

- Cardboard tube- Toilet roll or paper towel roll
- Paper
- Textas or pencils
- Scissors
- Aluminum foil
- Rice or dried Corn
- Tape
- Glue
- Funnel



What to do:

- If using toilet roll tubes, use 2 taped together.
- Trace the round end of your tube on a piece of paper, then trace a larger circle around it.
- Cut out the larger circle.
- Cut lines from the larger circle towards the smaller circle.
- Create a second one and leave it aside for later.
- With one of the circles, place the smaller circle over the end of your tube, fold down the slits you just cut and tape or glue them down. This will create a plug at the end of your tube.
- Pull out a piece of foil that's 2 or 3 times the length of your tube, scrunch it into a long thin bendy snakelike shape.
- Place that inside your tube.
- Using the funnel, pour your rice, dried corn or a mixture of both into your tube.
- Using your other cut circle, repeat the process to create a plug for the other end of your tube.
- Now decorate your tube however you like using your paper, textas and pencils.
- Once you are finished, hold your tube upright and listen to the rice move around to sound like rain. Turn it upside down to create more rain sounds.
