Resilient Wyndham looks at Wyndham's long-term resilience and will help to guide and manage the way Wyndham bounces back from the COVID-19 pandemic to adapt, survive and thrive in the face of future events such as climate change, extreme weather, natural disasters, pandemics, cyber-security attacks and economic downturn. Resilience is about being prepared for the unexpected.

Providing a four-year vision to 2025, Resilient Wyndham includes targets along with a yearly action plan to help strengthen Wyndham's resilience and ability to better prepare for future shocks and stresses. The Strategy captures what is already being done as well as identifying where we can do more

WHAT WE HEARD

A four-week consultation period commenced Wednesday 28 April 2021 and closed on Wednesday 26 May 2021, thank you to all stakeholders and residents who provided feedback.



85.71% believe Wyndham is currently 'somewhat resilient'



Storms / flooding / intense rainfall were identified as the priority shock for Wyndham



Level of support averaged 4 across all focus areas (**1 for no support, 5 strong support**)



71% of respondents provided comment on opportunities for actions



Engagement reach was **172,629** people, with **46** formal contributions were made via the Loop



Need for better representation of our **CALD, Ageing, Youth and Agriculture** sectors



Strong support for **food growing and swaps, mental health initiatives, greening activities and electric vehicles**

HIGHLIGHTS

The Strategy has been broken up into five focus areas being:



By 2030 all residents have knowledge and **access to fresh food** within their neighbourhood (growing or purchasing)



Increase in the number of people who **know their neighbours**



At least 25% potential canopy cover within streets across Wyndham by 2030 (moved forward from 2040)



Wyndham City residents are aware of and know **how to respond** to unexpected shocks



Wyndham City Council operations are **carbon neutral** by 2023 (excluding the RDF)



Halve household food waste to landfill by 2030



100 businesses participate in Wyndham Connect and feel more informed about future challenges and are able to put in place strategies to be better prepared
