

Build a Treehouse

Do you like the Treehouse series by Andy Griffiths? Design your own treehouse on paper. What kind of rooms will it have? A slide that goes to nowhere? A swimming pool? Pizza trampoline?

Do you want to take this one step further? Let's make a treehouse model! You will need something to build your treehouse with. This can be craft supplies, Lego or blocks. I used recycled items from around the house that I saved for craft projects. I used paper plates, cardboard rolls from paper towel and toilet paper, a cereal box and coloured paper.

How I built my treehouse:

- I used a paper plate as the base layer. Draw on some elements of your treehouse. Mine has a pool and a pizza trampoline.
- Cut a few slits into a cardboard roll on both ends and flatten these. This makes it easier to stick the cardboard roll onto the paper plate. I used another plate for the second level.
- I cut a small cardboard roll in half to make a slide and used sticky tape to attach it to the second paper plate.
- I covered the bottom part of a cereal box with paper to make a room for the treehouse.
- Make some leaves by scrunching green paper and sticking it to the underside of the second paper plate and onto another cardboard roll.
