### **Bookmark Competition Terms and Conditions**

- This competition is run by Wyndham City Council ('Council') in the state of Victoria, Australia only.
- 2. By submitting an entry to this competition on behalf of vour child, vou:
  - a. confirm that you are the entrant's parent or legal guardian ('parent');
  - b. consent to your child entering this competition;
  - accept these terms and conditions of entry.
- 3. Entries which do not comply with these terms and conditions will not be valid and will not be accepted.
- 4. Entrants must be aged between 5 and 12 and must live, study or socialise in Wyndham. Council staff. Councillors and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
- 5. The competition opens at 9:00am on 23 August 2021 and closes at 11:59pm on 8 October 2021 ('competition period'). Entries received outside of the competition period will not be accepted.
- To enter the competition, during the competition period you must:
- upload an image of your child's completed bookmark and submit a properly completed entry form at

- submit your child's completed bookmark and properly completed hard copy entry form at a Wyndham City Libraries branch during opening hours
- - a. be created using the template available in hard copy at Wyndham City Libraries branches or online at www.wyndham.vic.gov.au/ designalibrarybookmarkcomp;
  - meet the competition theme of "old worlds, new worlds and other worlds": and
  - not contain any offensive or inappropriate material, or infringe a third party's intellectual

- 9. Only one entry per entrant will be accepted. Entries will not be returned at the end of the competition.
- 10. The competition will be judged on 12 October 2021 by Council officers. Entries will be judged based on originality, skill, artistic merit and adherence to the competition theme. One winner and one runner up per age group will be selected, who will receive the prizes set out below (total prize pool valued at \$92). In addition to the prizes, the winner of each age group will have their entry published as a bookmark to be distributed at Wyndham City Libraries branches.

- 11. Winners' parents will be contacted by telephone or email by 15 October 2021 and winners will subsequently be announced on the Libraries in Wyndham Facebook page (www.facebook.com/ librariesinwyndham) and on Council's website (www.wyndham.vic.gov.au). You consent to the publication of your child's name in connection with the announcement of the competition winners.
- 12. If a winner's parent cannot be contacted by 5:00pm on 22 October 2021, Council may opt to conduct further judging to determine a new winner.
- 13. If a prize has not been claimed by 5:00pm on 29 October 2021, the winner will be deemed to have surrendered the prize and Council may opt to conduct further judging to award the unclaimed prize.
- 14. Council may require a winner's parent to provide evidence of the winner's identity and/or their connection to Wyndham. If there is a dispute as to the identity of a winner, Council reserves the right, in its entire discretion, to determine the identity of a winner.

- 15. Prizes are not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash.
- 16. You acknowledge that your child retains copyright in their entry.
- 17. You grant Council an exclusive, perpetual and royaltyfree licence to:
  - a. display your child's entry, in whole or in part, at any Wyndham City Libraries branch, whether in hard copy or on the branch's TV display screens; and
  - publish, cause to be published or otherwise use your child's entry in whole or in part on:
- a bookmark to be distributed at Wyndham City Libraries branches:
- Council's social media pages, including but not limited to the Libraries in Wyndham Facebook page (www.facebook.com/librariesinwyndham); and
- the Kids Club Gallery on Council's website (www.wyndham.vic.gov.au/kidsclub).
- 18. You acknowledge and agree that your child's name, as provided in their entry form, will also be displayed or published in connection with the display, publication and/or use of their entry as specified in condition 16.
- 19. You indemnify and hold harmless Council, its councillors and employees against all costs, claims and liability arising in connection with a breach or purported breach of these terms and conditions.
- 20. Council accepts no responsibility for late, lost, incomplete or invalid entries.
- 21. If for any reason the competition cannot be run as planned, Council reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition and/or amend these terms and conditions.
