

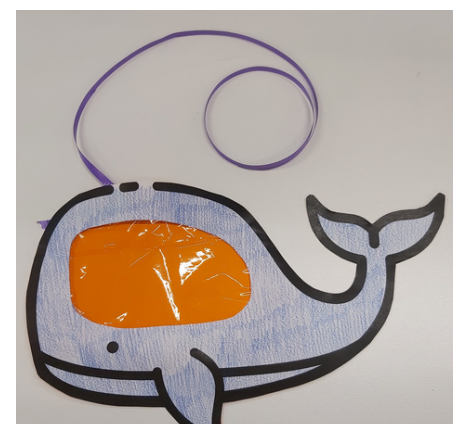
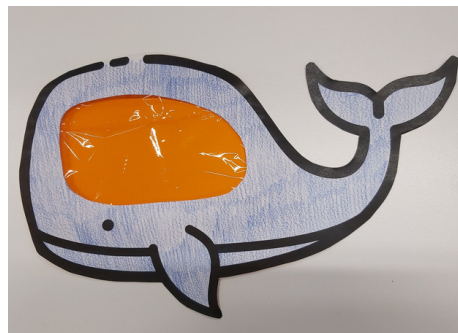
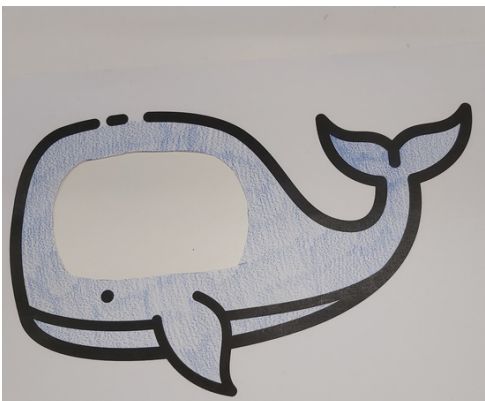
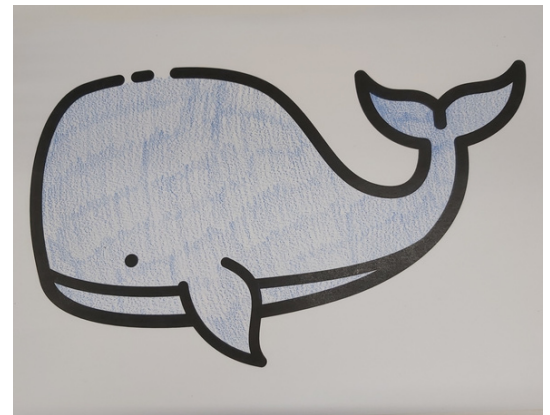
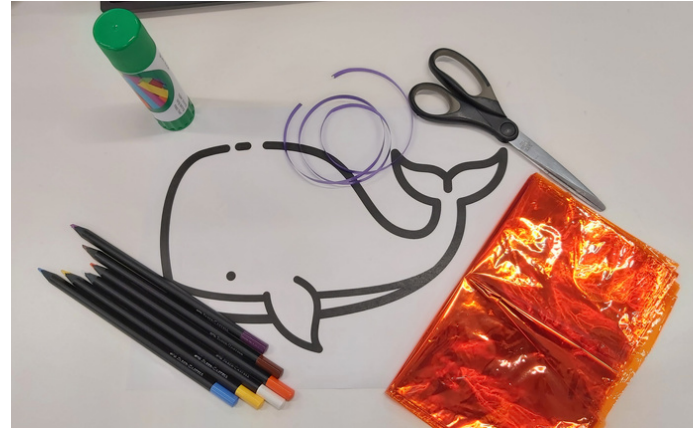
# Lightcatcher Whale

## What you need:

- Paper
- Cellophane
- Glue
- String
- Printer or Pencils/Textas
- Scissors

## What to do:

- Print the below images or draw your own whales', and colour it in.
- Draw a circle in the centre of both whales' bellies, this will be the line you cut along, make sure to leave a minimum of 2.5cm as the edge. Cut along that circle, easiest way to do this is to gently fold your paper in half and make a snip, cut your way to the edge of the circle and cut along the lines you made.
- Cut a piece of cellophane the size of your whale, using glue, stick it down on the belly using those 2.5cm edges we left.
- Stick your second whale on top, using those 2.5cm edges.
- Using your pencil, poke a hole in top of the head and thread through your string.
- Hang it where there's sunlight.
