

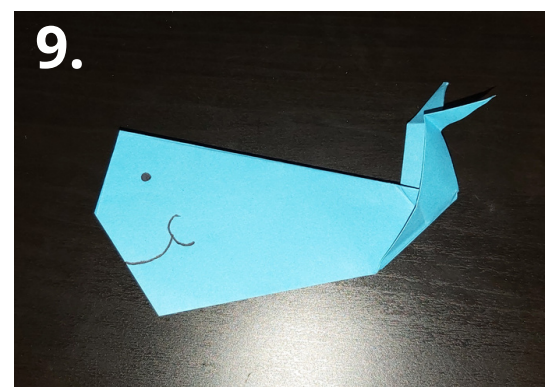
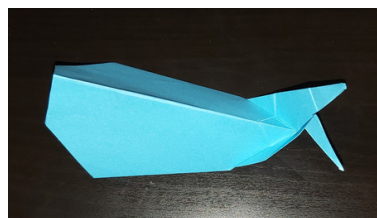
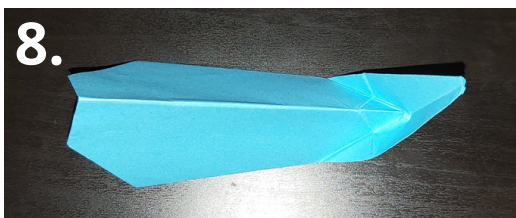
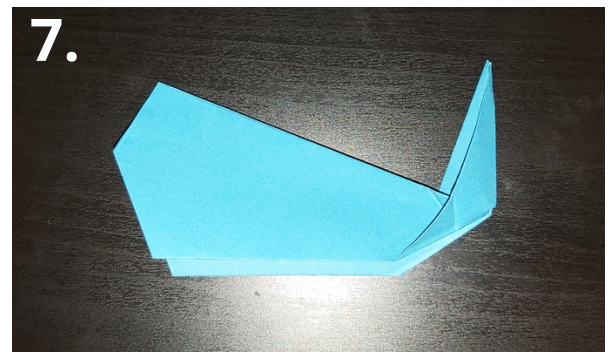
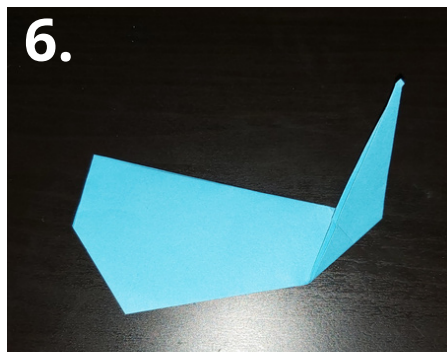
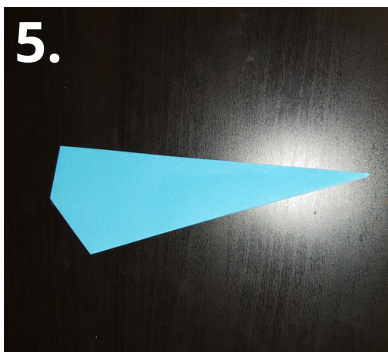
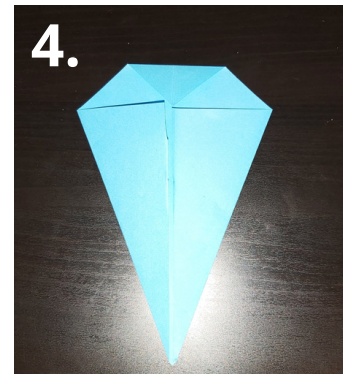
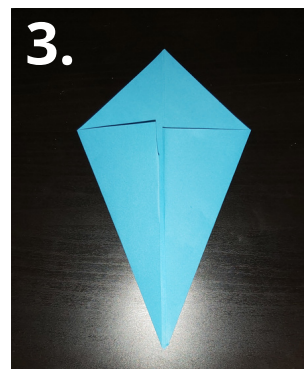
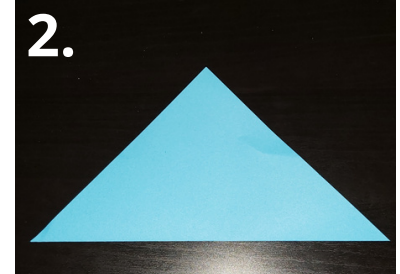
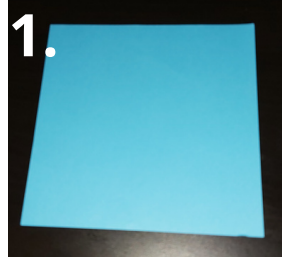
# Origami Whale

## What you need:

- Origami Squares
- Textas
- Scissors
- Flat surface

## What to do:

1. Start with an origami square.
2. Fold the square in half to make a triangle.
3. Unfold, and now fold the left and right to meet the centre.
4. Fold the tip down to meet the middle.
5. Now fold the whole thing in half.
6. Rotate to make sure your open fold is facing down, and fold your tail up, unfold and fold up again but on the other side of your paper, this will help with the next step.
7. Unfold your tail and gently fold it upwards.
8. Cut the tip of the tail down the centre and fold each side down.
9. Draw on your mouth and eyes on both sides of the whale.
