Pinwheel

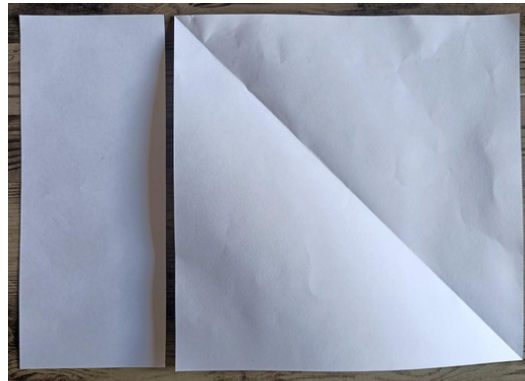
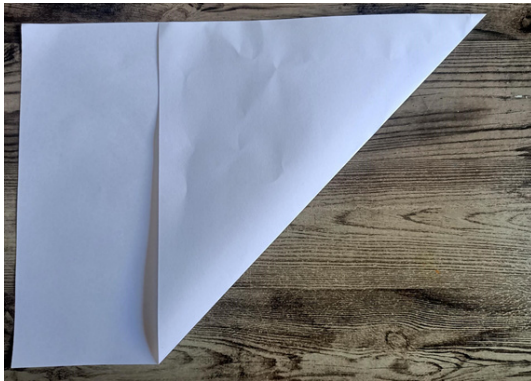

What you need:

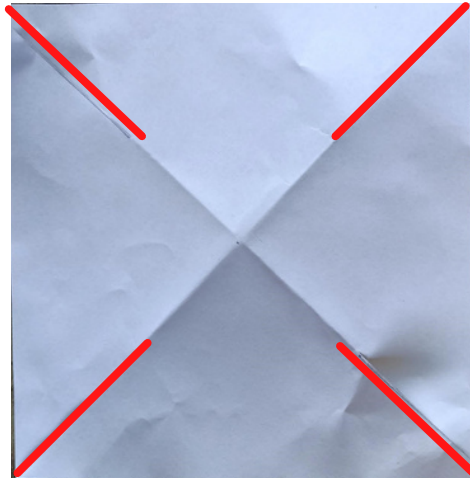
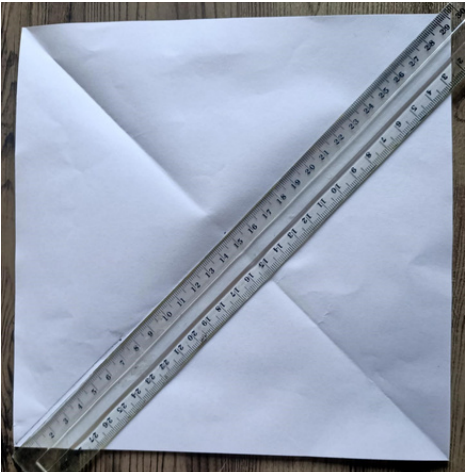
- Paper
- Skewer
- Colouring supplies
- Sticky tape
- Scissors
- Ruler

What to do:

- You need a square to make a pinwheel. To make a square from a rectangular piece of paper, fold one corner across the paper to make a triangle shape. Cut along the edge, unfold and you have a square.



- Fold the square in half to make a triangle again so when you unfold, you have two diagonal crease marks. Use a ruler to mark the halfway point on each crease mark. My square measured 15cm on the diagonal, so I marked 7.5cm down. See the red lines below to help you. Cut along these red lines.



- Colour in both sides.



- Pull every second corner to the middle of the square and glue the tip down in the middle.



- Carefully push a skewer through the middle of the pinwheel. Then use a small amount of sticky tape to secure the tips you glued down in the step above so they don't come unstuck. I wrapped some sticky tape around the skewer above and below the pinwheel to stop it sliding around on the skewer. Hold the skewer and turn your pinwheel around!
