

Moving Pirate Ship

What you need:

- Paper plate
- Paper
- Drawing supplies
- Scissors
- A stick type object, like a skewer, pencil or paintbrush
- Sticky tape

What to do:

1. On a piece of paper, draw the different parts of a pirate ship, making sure you keep them separated. I have drawn the wooden part of the ship and three sails. Cut these out.



2. On the paper plate, draw some waves about half way up the plate. Colour these in and cut them out.

3. Fold the waves in half and make a small cut.



4. Using sticky tape, tape the pieces of the pirate ship onto the stick object you are using, leaving space down the bottom. Carefully push this through the cut you made in the waves. You can hold the bottom of the stick and move it around so it looks like the ship is sailing in the ocean.
