

Paper Plate Snail

What you need:

- 2 paper plates
- Colouring supplies
- Scissors
- Glue/sticky tape



What to do:

1. One of the paper plates is for the snail's body. Colour this in and fold in half.
2. Cut the second paper plate around the edge to make it smaller. This will be the snail's shell. Colour it in.
3. Stick the shell onto the snail's body. Using some of the scrap paper you cut off the plate, draw the antennae and eyes. Cut these out and stick them on.
4. Sit the snail on a flat surface. Because the edge of the body is the curved part of the plate, the snail should rock back and forth. If the shell is making the snail too top heavy and it is falling over, try using a little bit of tape to stick the top parts of the plate closed and then hold the edges of the plate and puff them out a bit. Have a play around and you will eventually be able to make the snail rock back and forth.
