batman symbol painting



What you need:

- Black paper
- Paper
- Bright coloured paint
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Blu Tack

What to do:

- 1. Draw a Batman symbol on paper. Or if you have a printer, you can print out the image on the last page. Cut the symbol out.
- 2. Use Blu Tack to stick the bat onto the middle of the black paper. If you do not have Blu Tack, you can just carefully hold the image in place while you paint around it.
- 3. Paint over and around the bat on the page, so the colour goes over the black. You want it to look messy.
- 4. Mix some paint with water and mix your paintbrush around in the paint. Now hold the brush over the paper and tap the brush hard with your finger. It will splatter drops of paint over the paper. And everything else close by so do this outside if you can!
- 5. Leave to dry overnight. Carefully remove the bat from the middle of the page. If it rips a little, you can use black textas to make the black bat look neater.

What other superhero symbols can you use for your artwork?
