PAPER PLATE SPIDERS WEB

What you need:

- Paper plate
- Paper
- Glue/sticky tape
- Scissors
- Pencils/textas
- Pom-pom
- Wool/string/ribbon
- Hole punch

What to do:

- 1. Colour in the outside of the paper plate. Carefully cut the middle out.
- 2. Using a hole punch, punch holes around the edge of the plate.
- 3. Cut a long piece of wool and tie one of the ends through a hole. Thread the wool through a hole on the opposite side of the plate. Keep threading the wool in holes opposite to the one you just threaded to create a web effect. When you are happy with the way the web looks, tie a knot through a hole and cut off excess wool.
- 4. Draw a spider on paper and cut out. If you have a pom-pom, use it to make the spider's body. Glue the spider to the web.
