

Paper Spiderweb

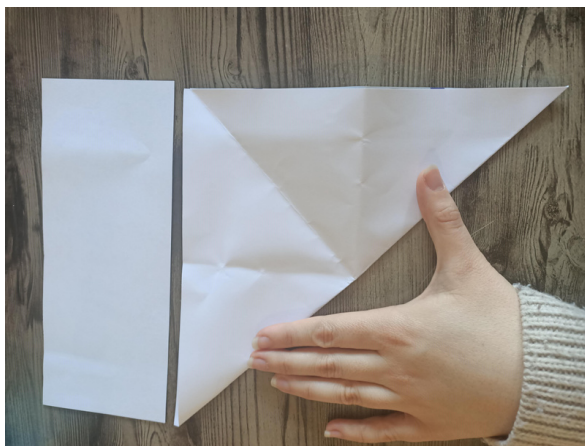
Let's make some paper spiderwebs so you can decorate your house for Halloween!

What you need:

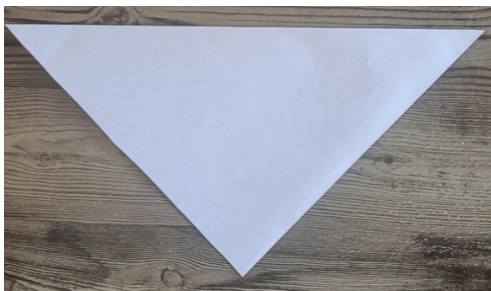
- White paper. Thin paper is better
- Scissors
- Pencil

What to do:

1. You will need a square for the spiderweb. To make a square from a rectangle A4 piece of paper, fold one of the bottom corners up as far as it will go to make a square, and cut off the rectangle at the top.



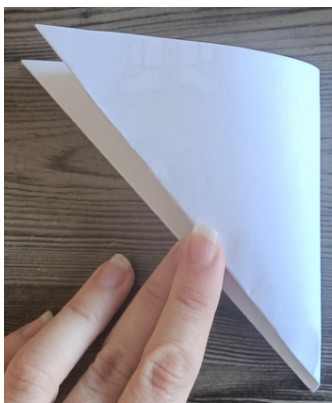
2. Fold the square into a triangle.



3. Fold the right corner to the left to make a smaller triangle.



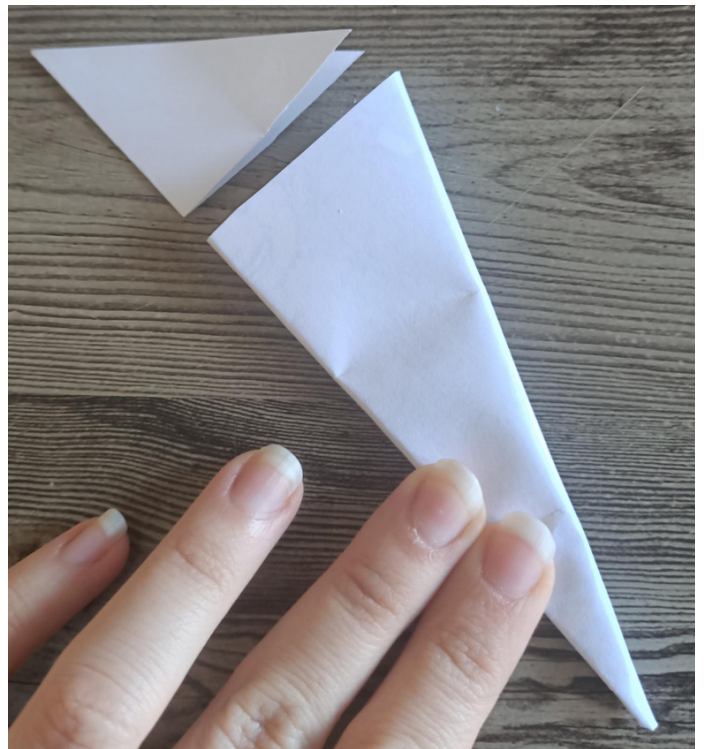
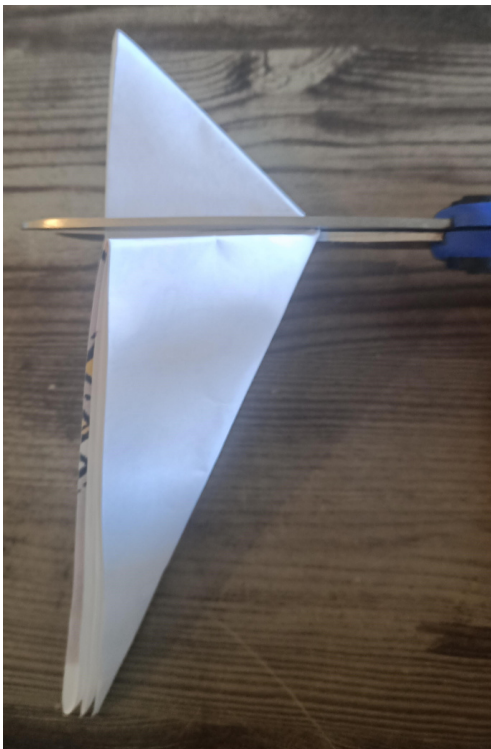
4. Fold the right corner to the left corner again to make an even smaller triangle.



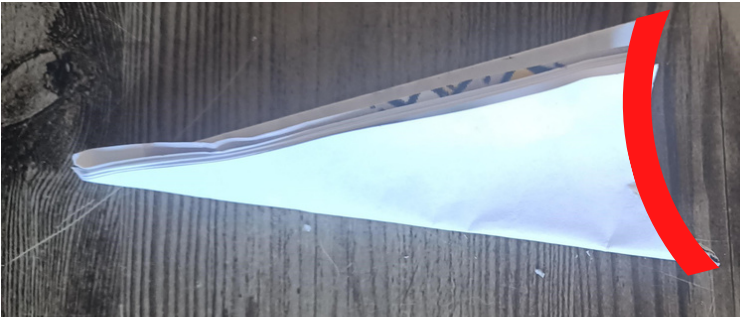
5. Your triangle now has one folded edge, one edge with three folds and one with unfolded edges of the paper. You are going to take the edge with one fold and fold across to the edge with three folds. Look at the picture to guide you.



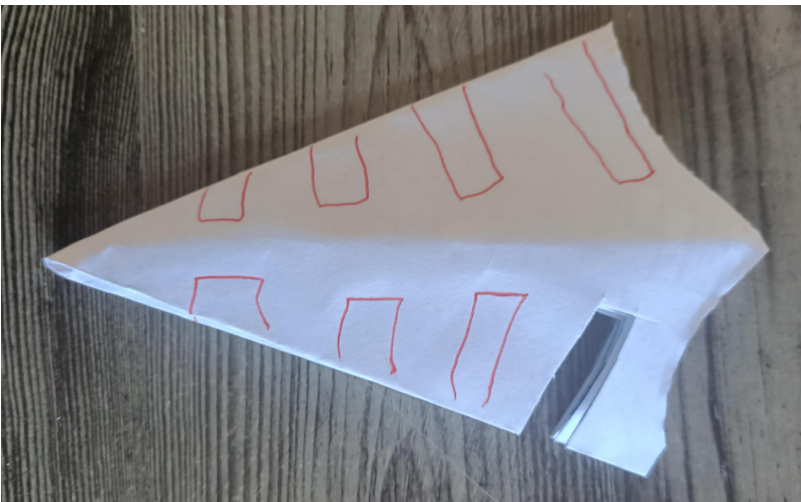
6. Now cut the triangle at the top off.



7. Cut the top edge again to make a curve. It's harder to cut now because the paper is thick with all the folds so be very careful. Ask for an adult's help if you are struggling to cut through the paper.



8. Draw lines for the spiderweb. These will be your cutting guide. You can see here I unfolded my triangle by one layer because I couldn't cut through the whole thing. This made it easier to cut.



9. Carefully unfold and now you have your spiderweb! How many can you make to decorate your house with? Make a spider for your spiderweb.

10. If you make a mistake and your spiderweb falls apart, that's OK. Mine did the first time too!
