Purple—Regal, Majesty	Orange—Ambition

Animals used on shields also had meaning:

Crab—Patience and cunning	Lion—Brave as a
Dragon—Courage	Owl-Wisdom
Falcon—Action	Snake—Wisdom
Fox—Intelligent	Tiger—Courage

Objects also had meaning: Anchor— Hope Arrow— Readiness Axe—Duty
