GIANT CASTLE DOOR

What you need:

- Cardboard
- Paint
- Paintbrushes
- Paper Coloured and white
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Blue-tac
- Glue
- Tape
- Doorframe



What to do:

- Cut your piece of cardboard into a rectangle shape, the same length as your door frame. Or Use a x3 A4 Sheets of paper taped together.
- Cut squares out the top of your rectangle. Paint or colour it black or dark brown.
- On 20 pieces of A4 white paper, draw bricks, colour or paint them black or dark brown. Once coloured tape them 7 together to create a long brick wall. Repeat for another 7 pieces. With the remaining 6 pieces, tape them together to create a large rectangle.
- Create paper strips, using A4 paper and your ruler. Make each strip the length of the paper and a ruler width wide. Cut along those lines.
- Using one of the paper strips you just created, glue each end together to create a ring, thread another strip through and glue the ends together. Continue until the length is a little longer than the door frame height.
- Once everything is dry, assemble your castle door, use blu-tac to stick your long brick walls to the side of your door frame.
- Use blu-tac to add the large rectangle with the squares cut out to the top of the door frame.
- Place the remainder brick rectangle to the floor in front of your door.
- Stick your paper chains to either side of the inner part of the door and to your brick paper on the floor.
- Using 1 A4 paper, design your own flag, cut triangles out of 1 edge. Add 1 long strip of paper to the other end to create a pole. **Optional
