

HOW TO DRAW A DRAGON

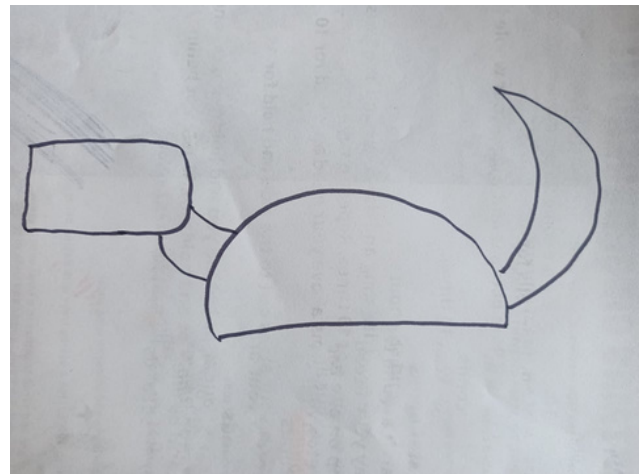
What you need:

- Paper
- Pencils/textas
- Grey lead pencil
- Rubber

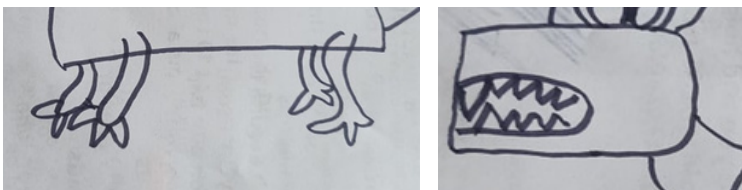


What to do:

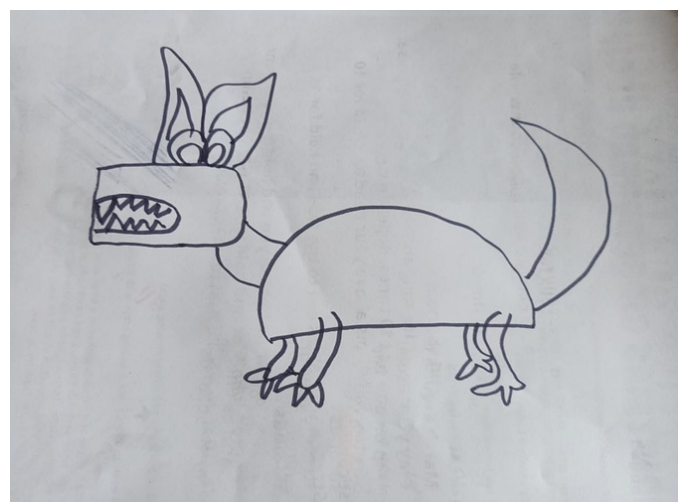
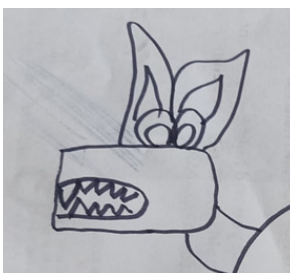
1. Start the dragon off by drawing a semi-circle for the body and a rectangle for the head. Use grey lead so you can rub out the extra lines later. I used black texta here so you can see it. Connect the head to the body with the neck. Add on the tail.



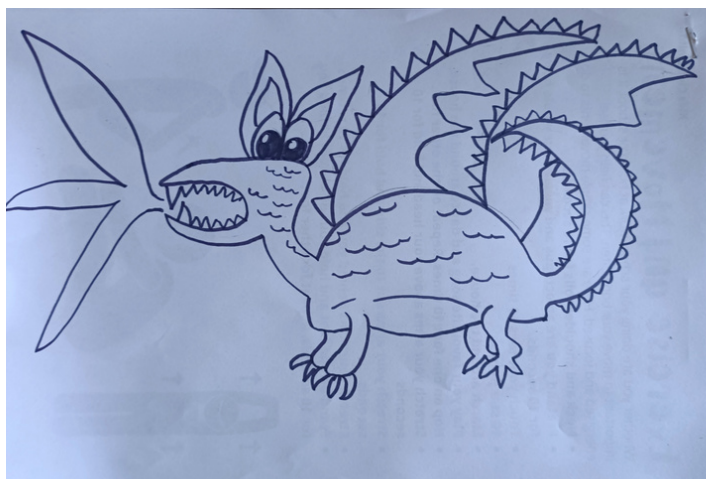
2. Add on legs and claws. Draw in the mouth on the bottom quarter of the rectangle.



3. Add two eyes and ears to the top of the head.



4. Add in extra details like scales, spikes, fire and scallops on the wing. When you are happy with how the dragon looks, go over the pencil outline with black texta. Don't draw over lines you want to rub out. Let the texta dry for a couple of minutes then rub out the grey lead.



5. Colour in the dragon. I used different shades of purple and blue to make the dragon have more depth. Add shadows by lightly using a black pencil to shade around the edges.



6. Add in a background for your dragon.
