Let's make some Fireworks!

What you need:

- A few sheets of white paper
- Colouring supplies
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Optional cellophane, ribbon, pipe cleaners and foil

What to do:

- 1. Colour in the white paper with different colours. Colour both sides. Then cut the paper into strips half way up, like in the picture.
- 2. Colour in and roll up another sheet of paper. This will be the base of the fireworks that you hold.
- 3. Now you will attach the rainbow paper to the base. Roll the paper around the end of the base and secure with sticky tape. If you want your fireworks to be fuller, colour in another sheet of paper, cut up like before and attach to the base.
- 4. If you have them, add strips of foil, cellophane, ribbons, pipe cleaners, anything to make your fireworks look sparkly and colourful. I added strips of foil to mine using sticky tape.
