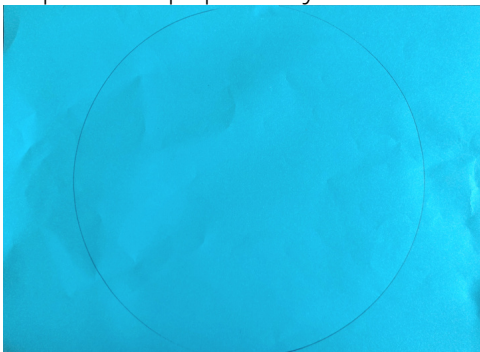


Paper Suncatcher



What to do:

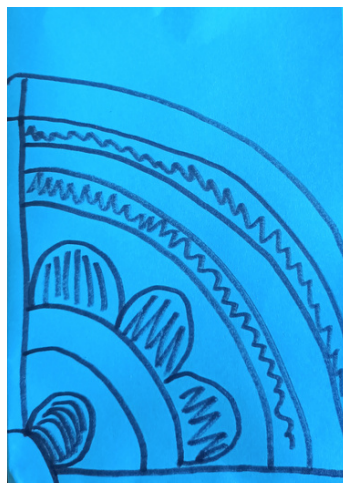
1. I have made two different shaped suncatchers here.
If you make a circle one, start by tracing around a plate on paper so you have a circle shape.



What you need:

- Paper
- Textas
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tissue paper, cellophane or baking paper

2. Draw the pattern for your suncatcher lightly in pencil. I used black texta here so you can see the pattern in the photo, but use pencil so it doesn't show through the other side of the paper. For my rectangle suncatcher, I folded the paper into quarters and drew the pattern. This way when I cut it out it will be symmetrical on all four sides. I shaded in the sections that I'm going to cut out. Then very carefully cut out the pattern.



3. Glue the tissue paper or cellophane onto the paper so it shows through the sections you have cut out. I didn't have either of these at home so I used kitchen baking paper. I cut a section the same size and the suncatcher and coloured a rainbow pattern on it with textas.



4. When the glue is dry you can use Blu-Tack or tape to stick your suncatcher to the window.
