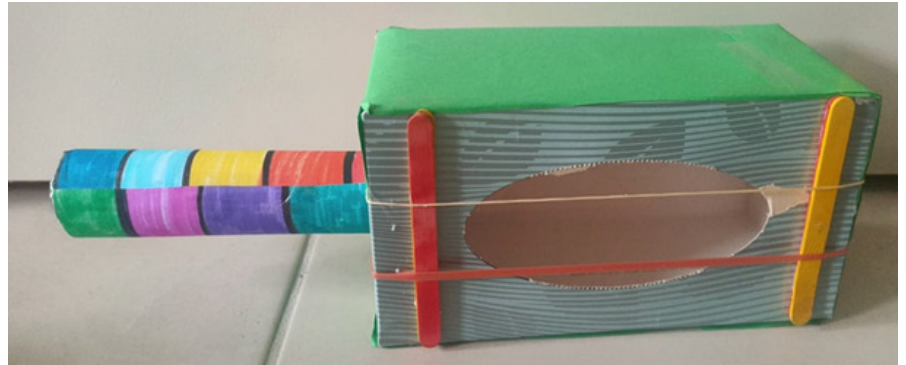


Tissue Box Guitar

This project uses recycled materials. It's a great idea to create a junk craft box. When you have an empty cardboard roll from toilet paper or paper towel, tissues boxes, clean cans, rubber bands and similar things, keep them in the box so when you feel like making something it's all ready to go.

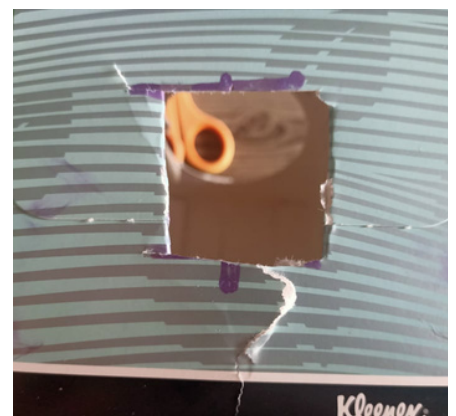
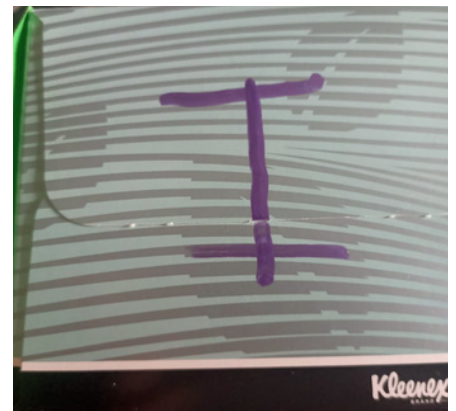
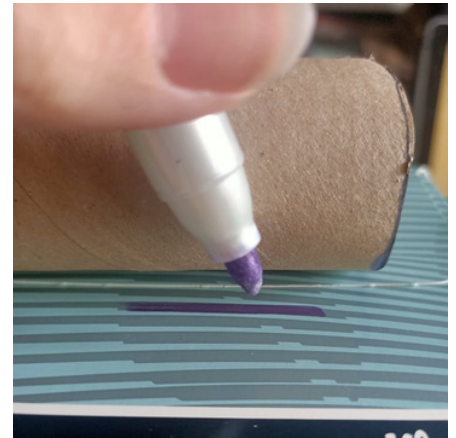


What you need:

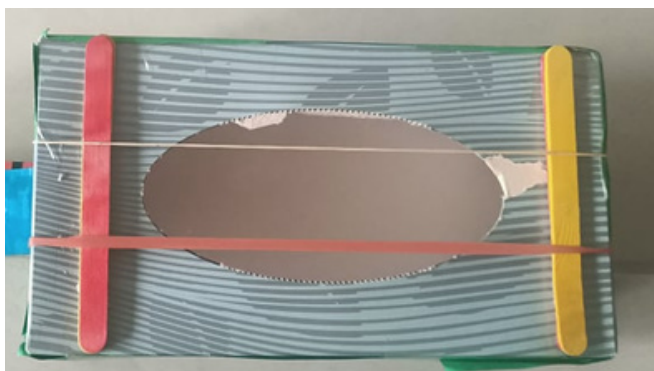
- Tissue box
- Cardboard roll
- 4 craft sticks
- A few rubber bands
- Pencils/textas
- Something to decorate the box with
- Scissors
- Craft knife
- Glue
- Sticky tape

What to do:

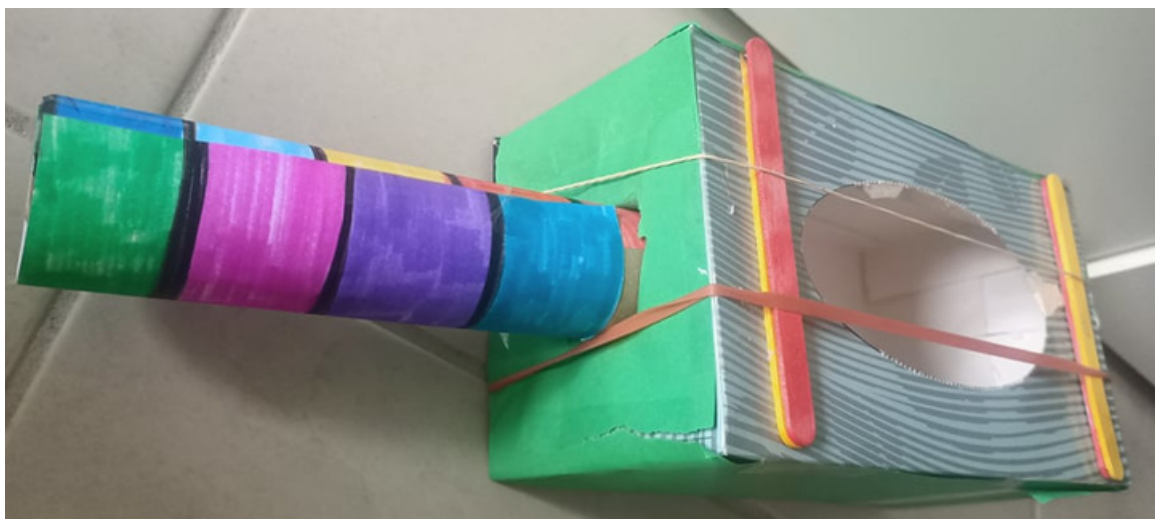
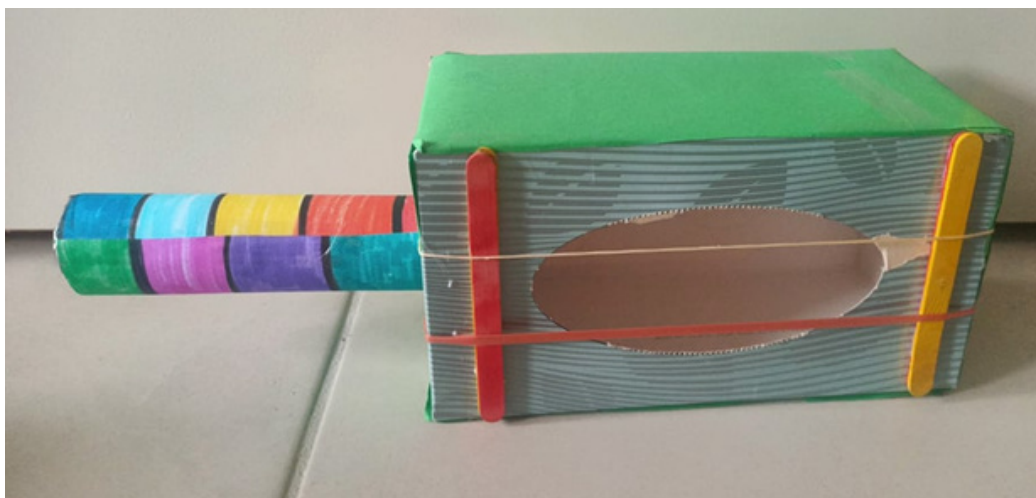
1. Remove the plastic from the hole at the top of the tissue box. You need to make a hole in the side of the box to fit the cardboard roll in. Measure around the roll and draw a 'H' like shape. Grab an adult to help, and using the craft knife, cut the 'H' shape and fold the flaps back.
2. Decorate the roll and the box. I coloured in paper and taped it to the roll. And I covered the sides of the box with coloured paper. Slide the roll through the cut you made. Use some tape to secure it on the inside.



3. Glue two craft sticks together. Repeat with the other two. Leave to dry then glue onto the box as shown in the picture. Leave to dry again.



4. Place the rubber bands on over the box so they go over the top of the sticks and the hole in the box. If you can, use different size rubber bands. Now have a go! Strum your guitar. What kind of sound does it make?
