

Nature

Suncatcher

What you need:

- Popsicle sticks
- Leaves, flowers or anything else you can pick up from a nature walk.
- Clear contact
- Textas
- Scissors
- String
- Glue

What to do:

- Go for a nature walk and pick up some leaves and flowers.
- Colour in 8 popsicle sticks with any design you like.
- Glue 4 of the popsicle sticks together in a square shape.
- Cut 2 pieces of clear contact the same size as your square.
- Peel the backing off 1 piece of contact and start sticking on your leaves and flowers.
- Stick your popsicle square over the top of the sticky side of the contact.
- Cut a length of string and stick it both ends on the top of the contact to create a handle.
- Peel the backing off the other piece of contact and stick it on top of the flower contact square, sticky side down. This will seal your suncatcher.
- ***Optional** Glue the reminder 4 of the popsicle sticks together in a square shape. Stick them to the other side of the previous square.
- Hang it somewhere in direct sunlight.
