

PAPER PLATE CROCODILE

What you need:

- Three paper plates
- A4 Paper
- Colouring supplies
- Scissors
- Glue/tape/stapler

What to do:

1. Colour in the paper plates. I coloured the body of my crocodile green, and the other plate which will be the mouth is green on one side and red on the other.
2. Draw teeth across the long length of the paper. Draw some large eyes. Cut them out.
3. To make the mouth of the crocodile, fold the paper plate in half. Then I used tape to stick the teeth to the edge of the red side.
4. To attach the mouth to the body, I used glue and staples to stick the folded plate on one half of the green plate. Then I used tape to attach the eyes above. You can make the crocodile's mouth open and close. Snap! Snap!
