

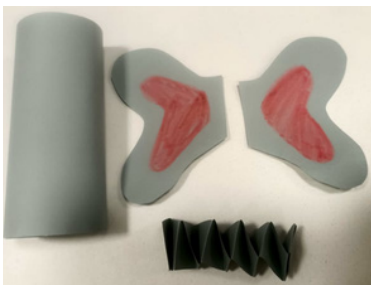
Paper Roll Elephant

What you need:

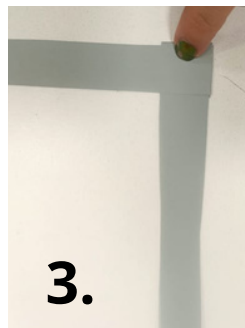
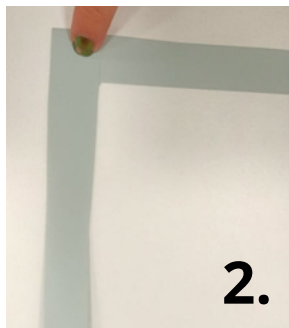
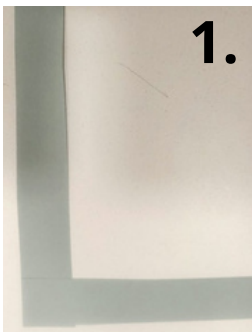
- Paper roll
- Paper
- Glue/sticky tape
- Pencils/textas

What to do:

1. Cover or colour in the paper roll. This will be the elephant's body.
2. On paper, draw the ears and cut out.



3. Cut two strips of paper and accordion fold these together. Lay the strips out so they make an 'L' shape and glue the end of the right strip on top of the bottom of the other strip. Fold the top strip down, and fold the right across to the left. Fold the bottom strip back to the top, and the left across to the right. Keep repeating this until you run out of paper and glue the ends together. See images 1, 2 & 3.



4. Attach the ears and trunk to the body of the elephant and draw in any details.
