Top Countries of Birth

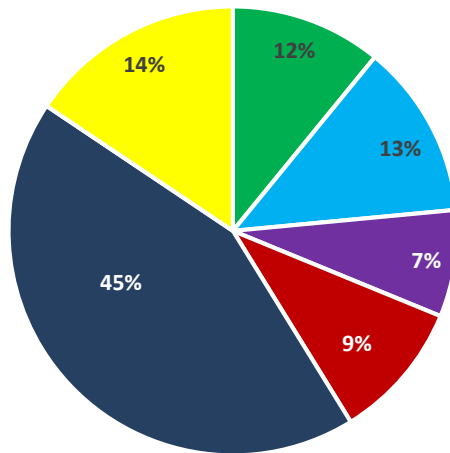
