Wow! Where is the time going? Can you believe we're heading into Term 3?



Your Heart Matters



Iramoo Community Centre held a Heart Matters session at the Centre on Monday the 20th of June. James Nigro attended the session to highlight the importance of maintaining good heart health. Ambulance Victoria, the Heart Foundation and Monash University started a community outreach project called Heart Matters to ensure residents can recognise the warning signs of a heart attack, and the ways to reduce the risk of suffering heart disease. Offering this Heart Matters talk allowed the community to chat with James, ask questions and get a better understanding on ways to reduce heart disease.

We hope the session provided the community with ways

to reduce their chances of heart disease by exercising, eating well, managing their stress levels, and seeking help when needed. We also hope members now know how to recognize if a friend or family member is showing signs of a heart attack and when to call for help. Heart Matters is being delivered in regions of Victoria with the highest risk of heart attack and low levels of hearth health knowledge, and ambulance use.




