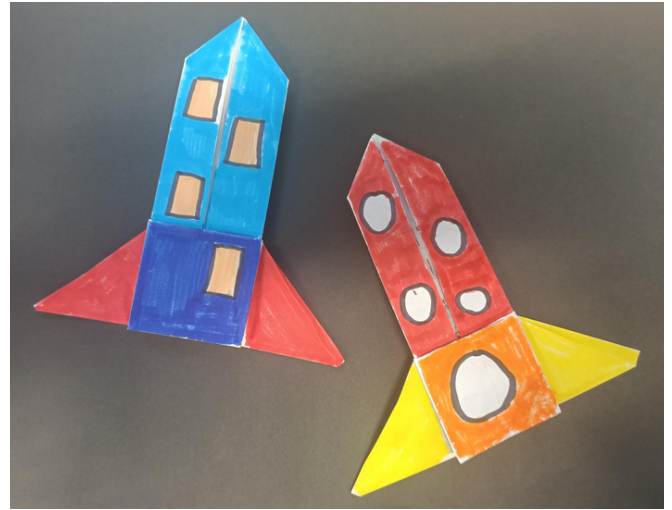
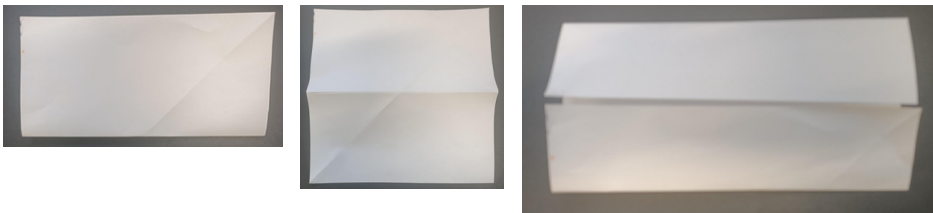


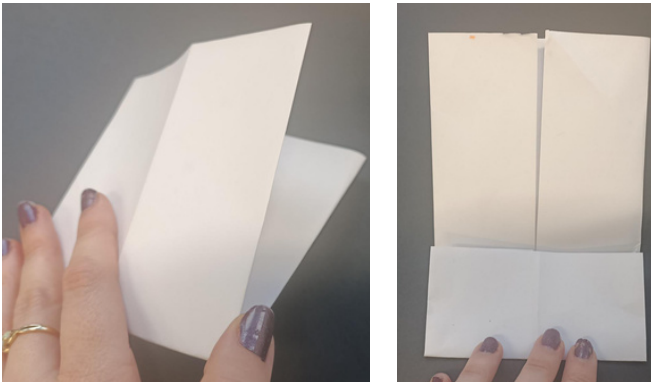
ORIGAMI ROCKET



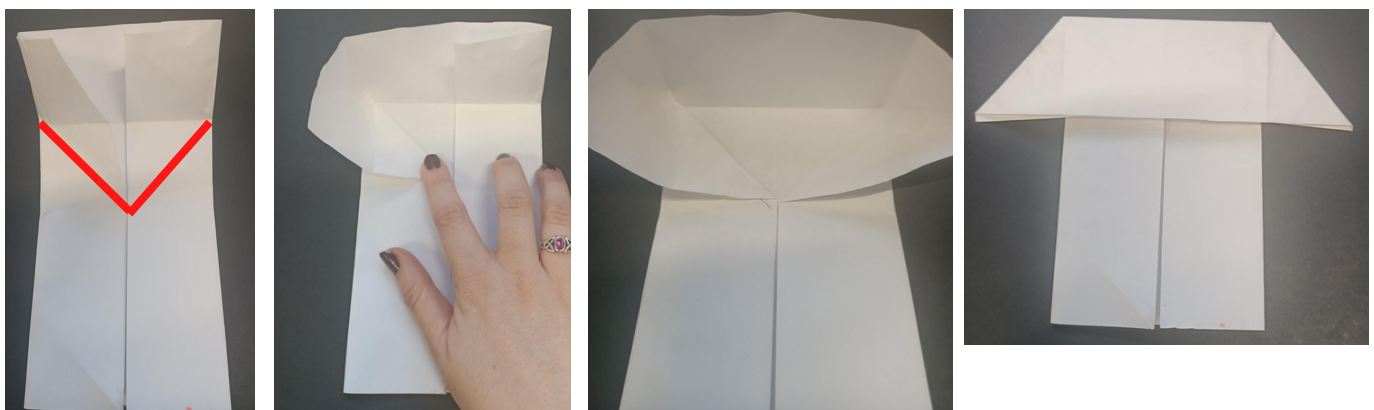
- Start by folding a square piece of paper in half, then unfold. Fold the edges up to meet the centre crease.



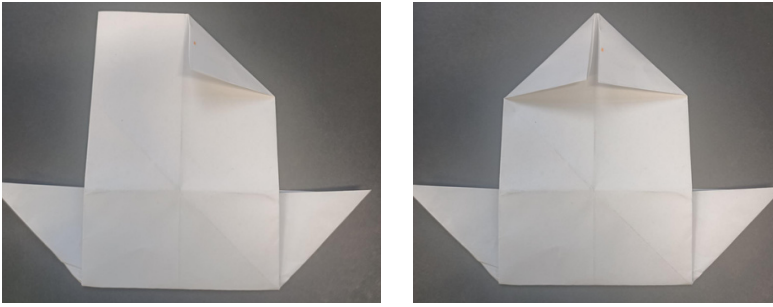
- Fold the piece in half to make a crease, then unfold. Fold one of the short edges up to meet the centre crease, then unfold.



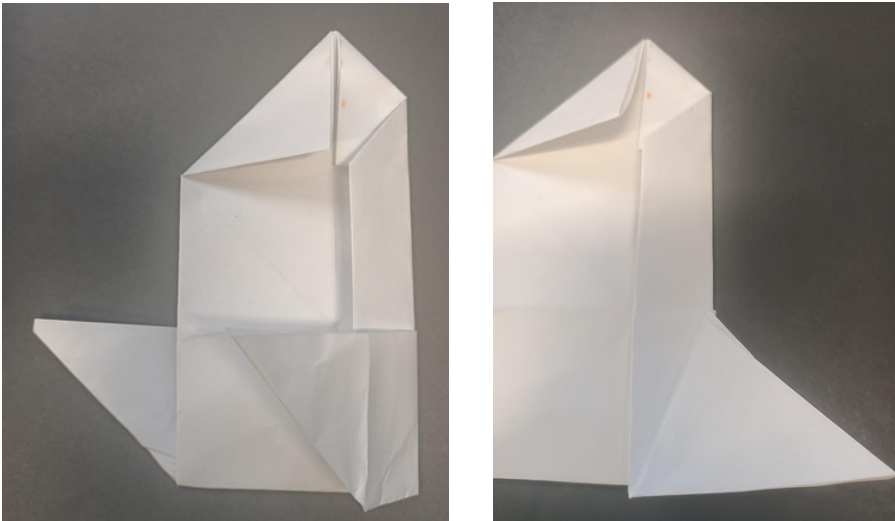
- Rotate the piece around so the crease marks you made in the previous step are at the top. This next step is tricky! You will be making a squash fold. Using the creases made from the previous step, start by folding the inside corner out along the red diagonal line (one side at a time), so the end of the paper opens up. Squash fold this down so it looks like the image here.



- Rotate the piece and flip it so it matches the picture below. Fold the top corners down to make triangles.



- Fold one side to meet the middle. Then fold the bottom triangle out and down. Repeat on other side



- Turn the piece over and now it's finished! Colour the rocket in.
