LOKI AND THOR PUPPET Show

Do you like telling stories or putting on plays? You can create your own puppet show using Thor and Loki and the backdrop provided. You might like to draw other characters and backgrounds as well.

What does a great play need? You need a story with a beginning, middle and an ending. There also needs to be a problem, conflict or situation that needs to be resolved by the end of the play. Thor and Loki are brothers and had had many adventures together. You might like to make up a play about their adventures.

Cut out Loki and Thor and attach to paddle pop sticks or paper straws. These are the characters for your puppet show.

Your theatre can be made out of a box, with the background attached, or you can put the background picture up on a wall and hold the puppets up in front of that.


You could get the whole family involved—as audience, as musicians or as puppeteers.

Other characters you could include in your puppet show are Odin (father to Loki and Thor), Fenrir the wolf or Frigga Queen of Asgard (Mother to Thor and Loki)
