On the 27th of August 2022, as part of the Resilient Wyndham Building Blocks Program 2022, our team of seven (Arooj, Carla, Geetha, Genaaleen, Muhammad, Sally, Taslima) and our guest presenters (Ena, Irene, John, Preeti and the Club 60 Wyndham Vale Men's Group) delivered a heartfelt, energy filled event that was enjoyed by up to 65 attendees.

It all began with an acknowledgement to country which was

beautifully spoken by Anne, and set sail on a journey through the pacific islands. The program started with a key note speech from Genaaleen on Emotional Fitness and The Power of Your Perspective, inviting the community to consider that their feelings are valid and a difference in opinion is only a matter of perspective. It's not about right or wrong; it's about finding what works for all. This was followed by breathwork by Geetha, allowing the audience to be centred and grounded.

Ena graced us with a wonderful tribute to seasons and Samoan traditions, leading to dance as a means of expression. This was followed by Carla's interactive, entertaining yet moving presentation on a Maori practice that brings connection through cultural movement and song. Then, John shared a Fijian practice that connects people for relaxation and traditional gatherings - Kava Ceremony, which was enjoyed by the guests and presenters alike. This was followed by some solemn words and high energy dancing from the Club 60 Wyndham Vale Mens Group where everyone got up on their feet. In her artistic flair and heartfelt truth, Irene shared 'Art as Therapy' inspiring creativity and expression amongst the crowd. She painted some river stones which symbolises the community at Wyndham - a community that can weather the storm and emerge in its beauty. Finally, Preeti gave us a wonderful dance that certainly moved the energy in our bodies and led us to the light refreshments on offer by the Connecting Carers group.

It was a fantastic day for connection, learning, appreciation of cultures and filling our hearts with joy and laughter!
