INDIGENOUS CULTURAL INFUSION

Leading up to Cultural Diversity Week the Point Cook Community Learning Centre is hosting an Indigenous cultural infusion.

An Acknowledgement of country and smoking ceremony will be held at the front of the centre. The smoking ceremony is a traditional Aboriginal custom which involves burning native plants just enough to produce smoke. The smoke will cleanse the area and ward off bad spirits from the people and the land.

This highly interactive and engaging program enables students to explore different cultural aspects such as Dance and Didgeridoo, Indigenous Artefacts and Storytelling.


