

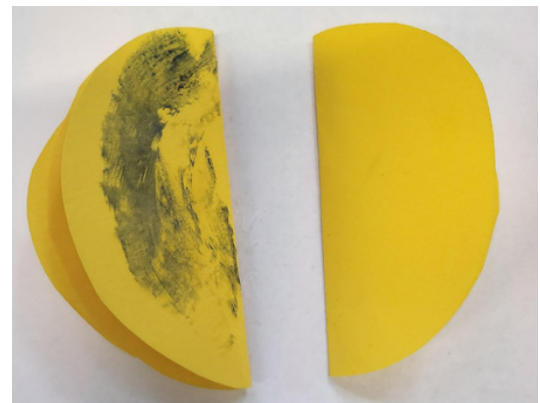
3D Chick Easter Card

What you need:

- Thick paper for the card
- Paper
- Pencils/textas
- Scissors
- Glue

What to do:

1. Fold the thick paper in half to make a card.
2. To make the body, you need four circles of paper the same size. You can print the circles on the next page and cut out.
3. If you do not have a printer, fold a piece of paper in half, then in half again. Use something like a mug to trace a circle onto the paper. Cut out and you will have 4 circles the same size.



3. To make the chick's body, fold three of the circles in half. Cover one side of a circle in glue. Stick another circle onto this. Glue the other side, and stick the third circle down. Cover the fourth circle with glue and stick down the 3D circle.



4. Draw a background for the chick on the card. Stick on the chick's body and add the wings, eyes, beak, and legs. Write a happy Easter message inside and give the card to a friend.
