



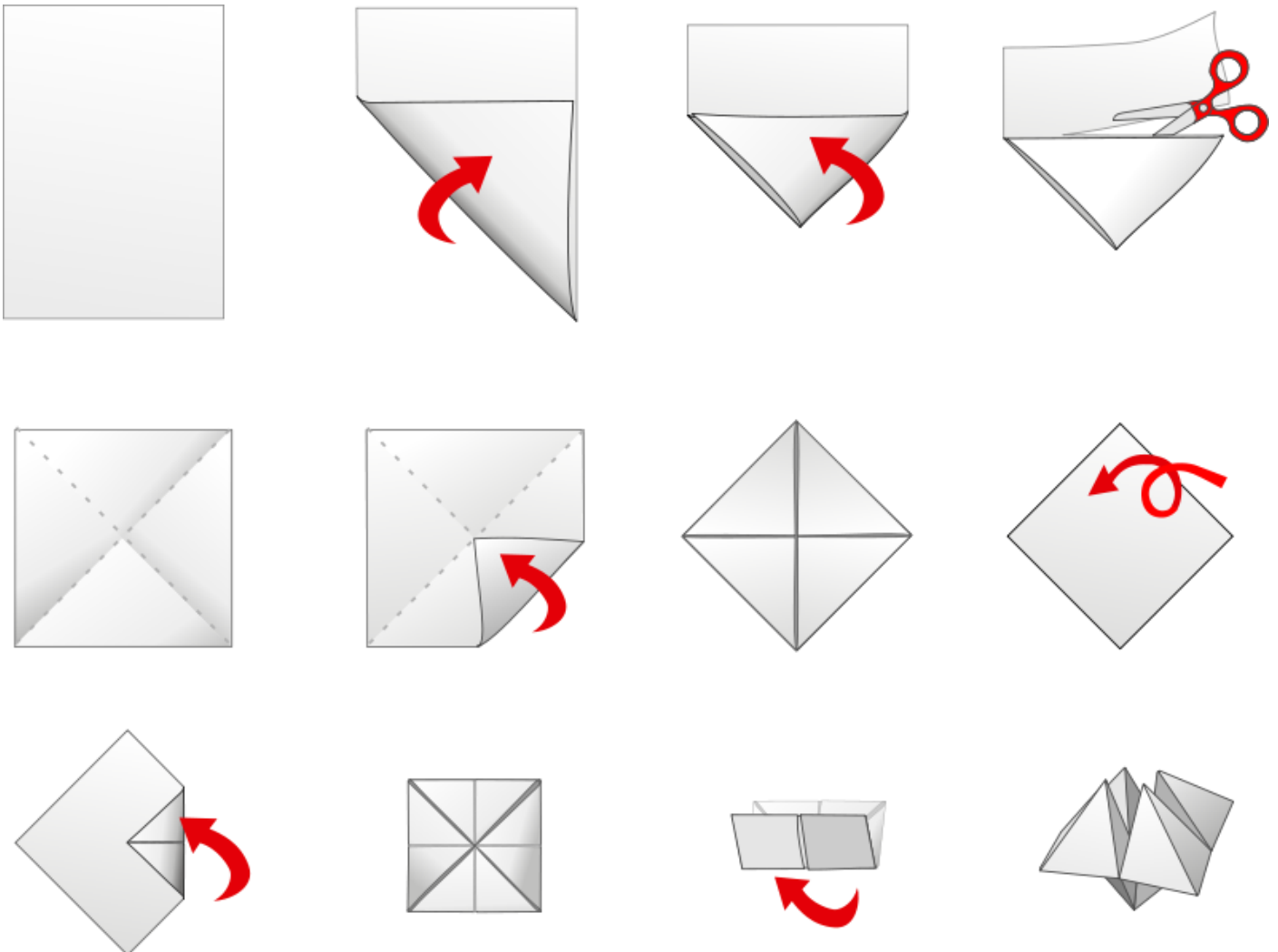

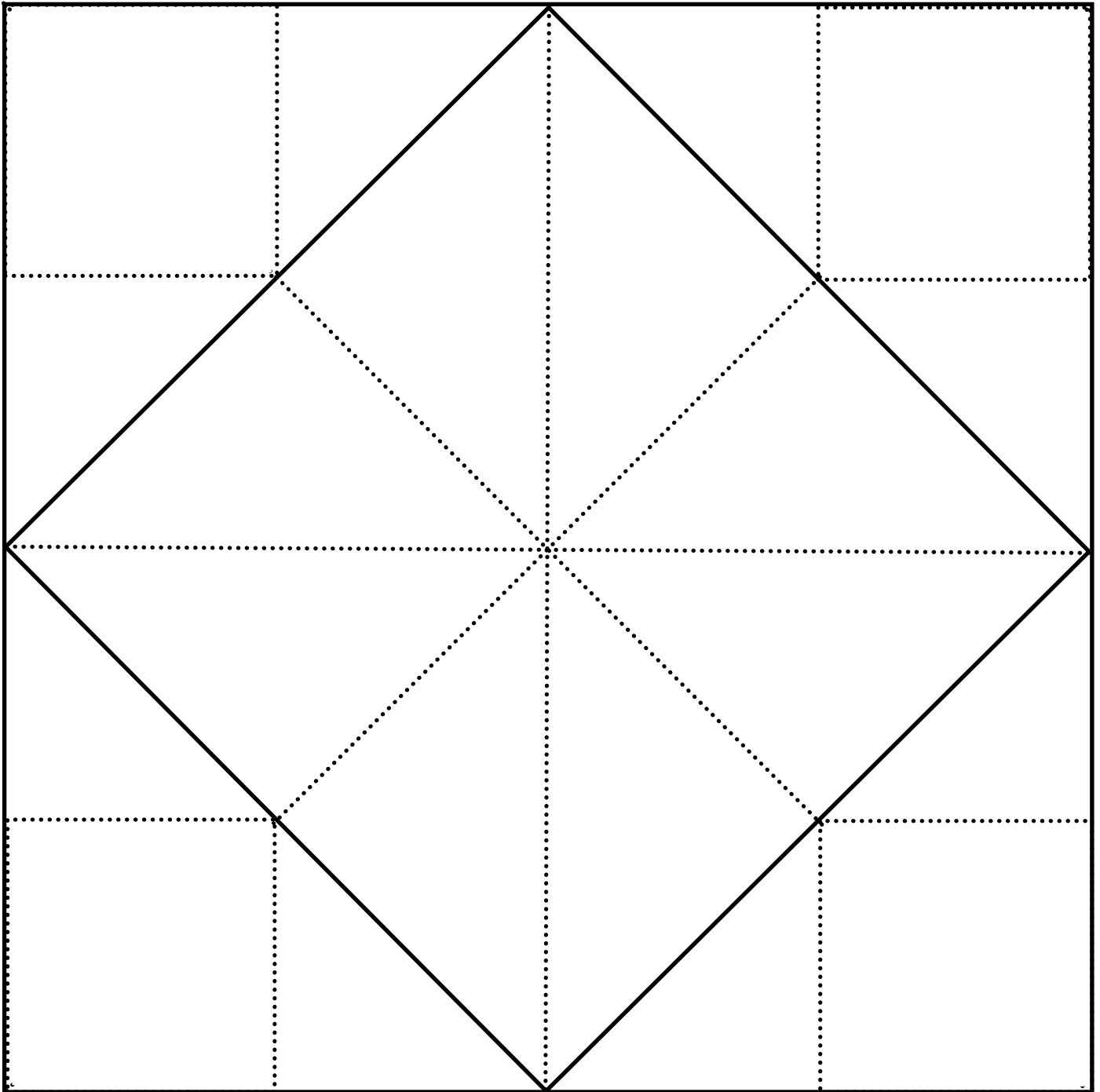

How to Make:

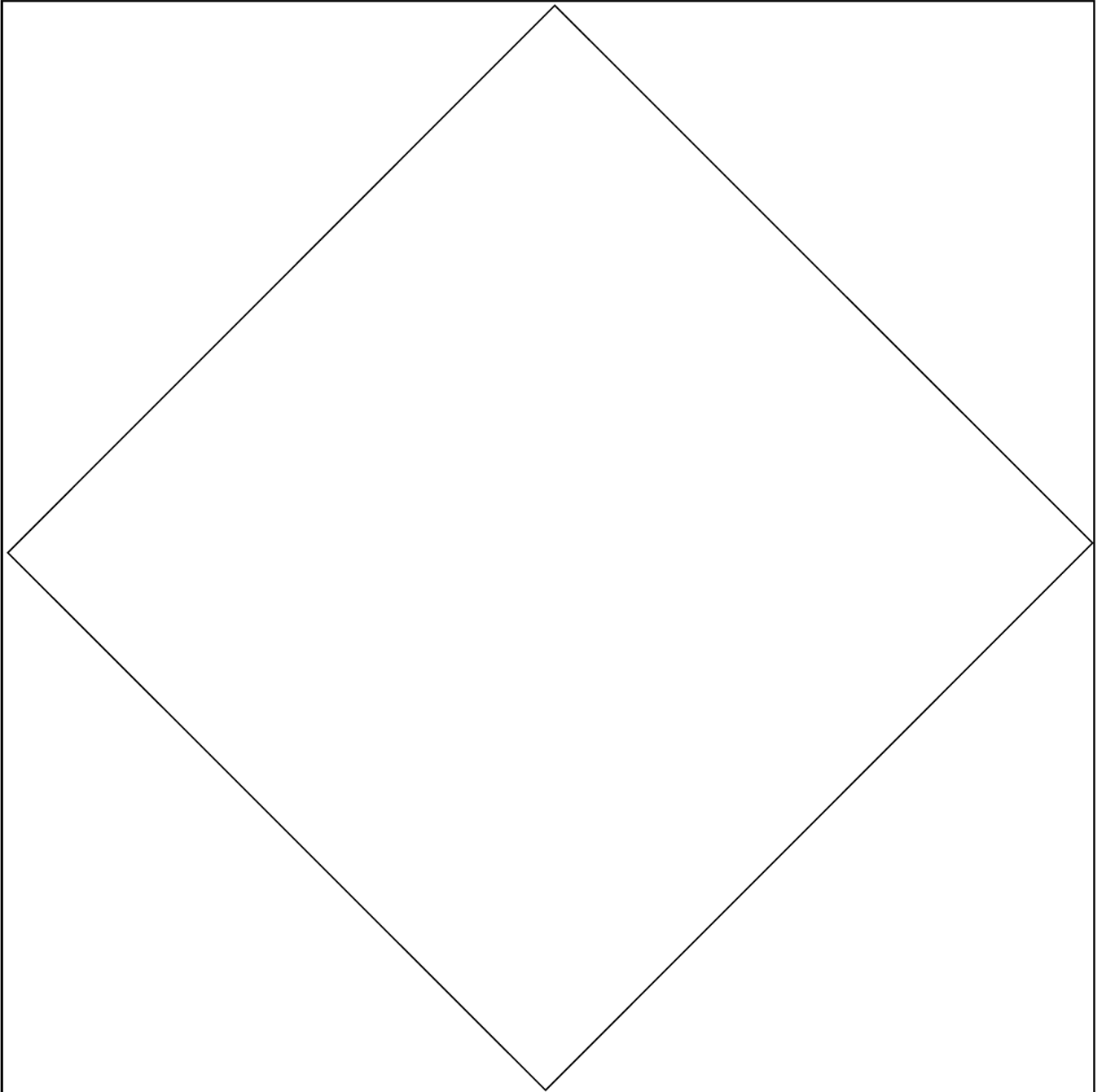
