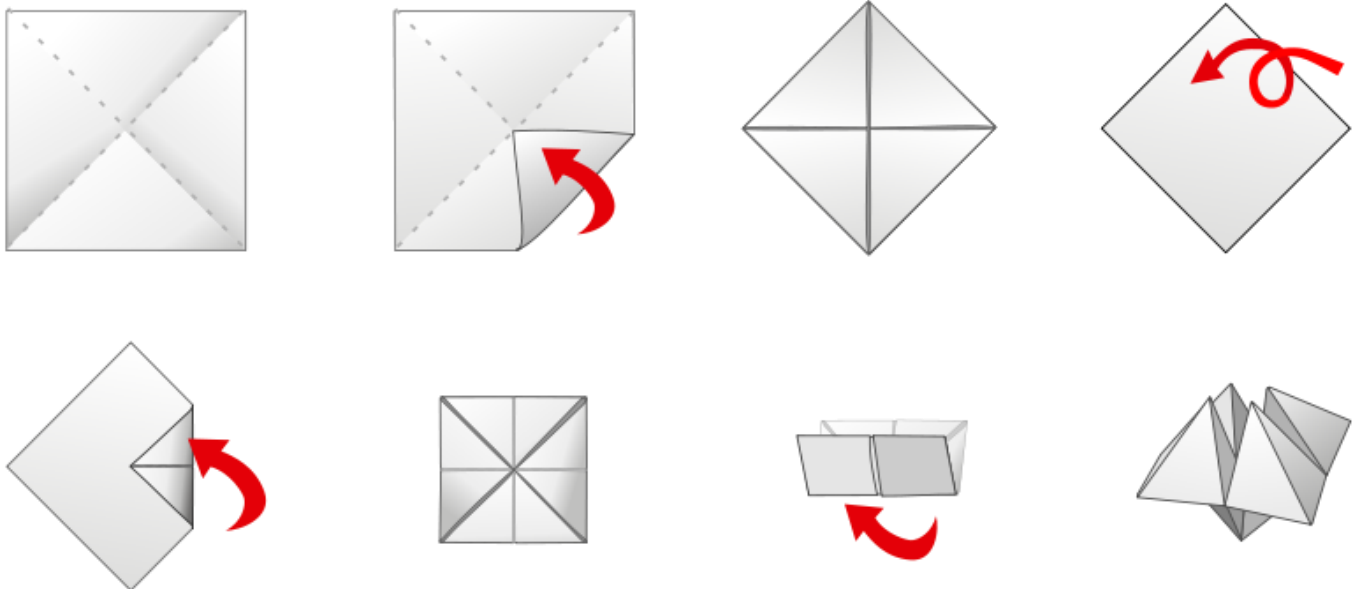

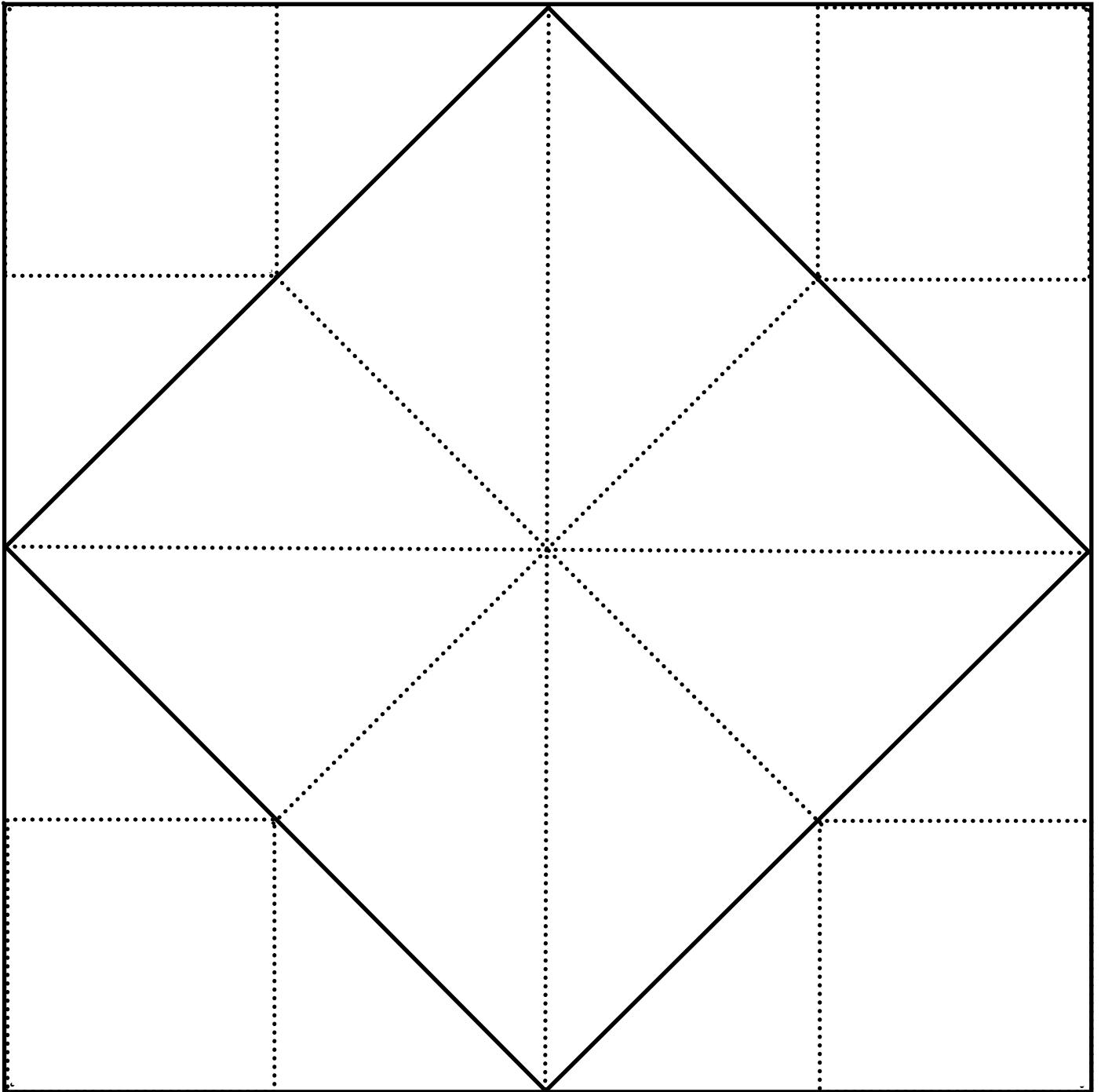

## How to Make:

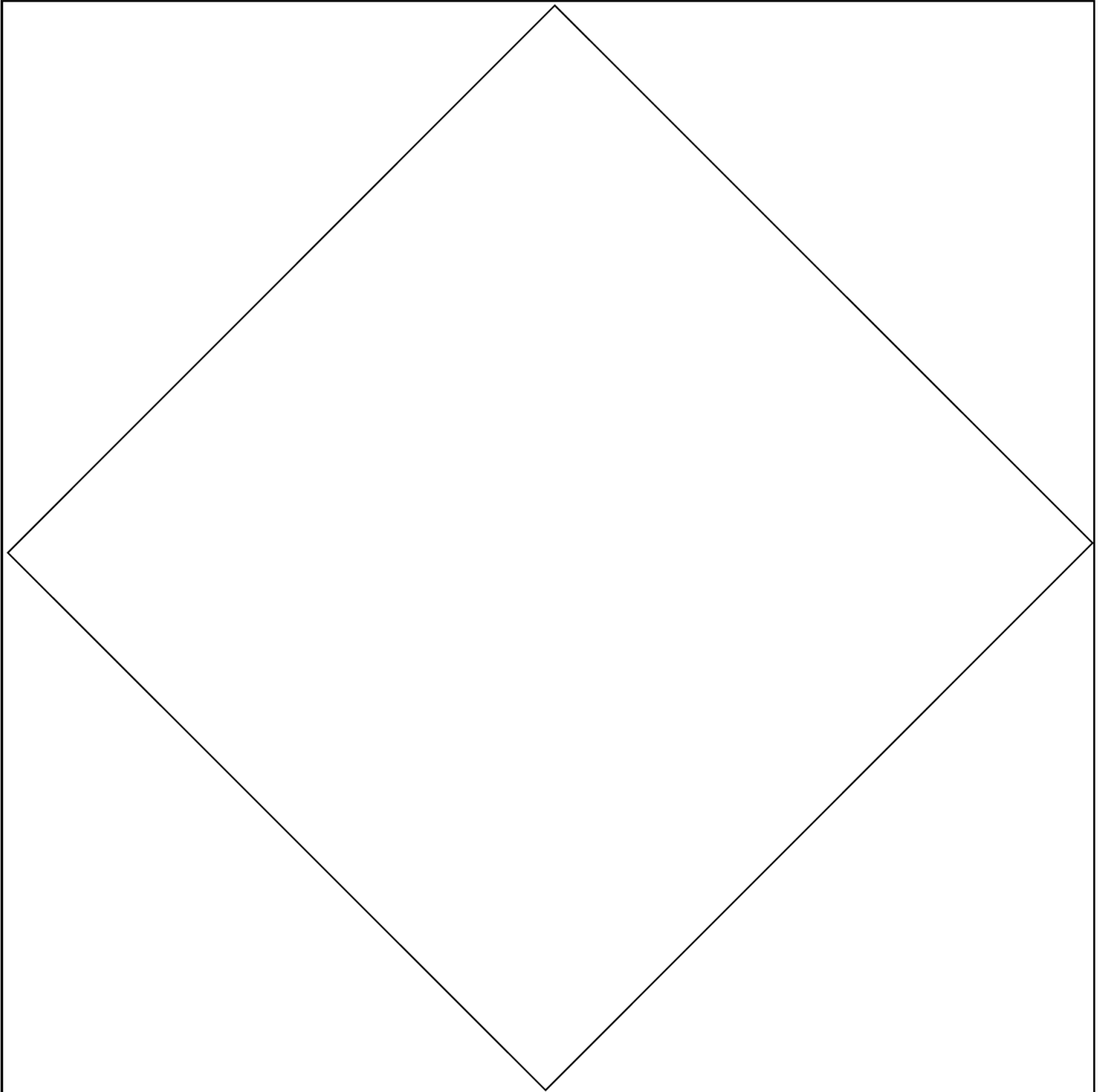
