ACTIVITIES

TOILETS

If I need to go to the toilet, I will let my adult know and they will take me there.



PEOPLE

There will be a lot of people and children there.

I will need to stay close to my adult.

I can wear a wristband with my adult's phone number on it.



FOOD

If I am allowed and I bring money, I can get food from a stall.



Or I can eat food I bring from home.



WATER

I can bring my own water bottle and fill it up at the water fountain.



STAFF

If I need help, I can find event staff to help me.

They will be wearing a dark blue shirt that says EVENT STAFF on the back.



Going to Children's Week Picnic will be super fun!



SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER

It might be sunny and hot, remember to wear a sunhat.
Sunscreen will be available at the information marquee.

It might be cold, so remember to bring a jumper.

Get a Wristband at the gate to write the phone number of my carer, or parent, so they can find me if I get lost.

Remember to bring my water bottle.

The park where the festival is has grass and gravel paths so wear comfortable shoes.

Either bring my own food or bring money to buy food.

Remember to protect my hearing - I can bring headphones.

Treat other festival goers with respect, and they will do the same to me.
