In the lead up to Homelessness Week (7-13 Aug) Wyndham City Council coordinated a donation drive (toiletries, food, underwear, blankets & towels). Once the donations were received the community had an opportunity to attend a morning tea at the Manor Lakes Community Learning Centre or a dinner at the Dianella Community Centre whereby they assisted with packing the donated items into Dignity packs. As a result of the donations received Dignity packs were created. Along with the morning tea & dinner, Council hosted a movie screening; "Undercover" (documentary about Australia women over the age of 50 experiencing homelessness) along with a light lunch with a panel discussion at Point Cook Community Learning Centre.

Approximately 280+ community members attended the events across 3 community centres. These events included presentations from H3 Alliance representatives (Unison, Uniting and others), HAAG representatives, Council Community Connectors, Youth Services & guest speakers who spoke of their lived experience with homelessness & of the local issues. We were blown away with the generosity from the community, local organisations, businesses & community groups who donated so many personal care items & food & as a result over 300+ Dignity packs were created & distributed to all Wyndham Community Centres, these are now available for the community to access. Thank you all!

Upgrading Saltwater Community Centre

Wyndham City is undertaking a series of upgrades to Saltwater Community Centre as part of Council's Building Asset Renewal Program. Improvements include an upgrade to the heating and cooling system to improve thermal comfort for the centre's user groups, safety improvements to access points and upgrading the foyer area to a standard befitting the rest of the building. These upgrades will improve the safety and overall functionality of Saltwater Community Centre, providing a better experience for our community.

Work commenced on Monday, 18 September and is expected to run until early 2024.

Some general construction noise can be expected while these works are undertaken, and some of the centre's car parking spaces may be taken up by a crane and/or other construction machinery at different stages of construction. The centre's programs and services will continue to operate throughout construction however, there will be brief disruptions to program timetables (1-2 weeks) due to room unavailability. Regular programming updates will be provided at Saltwater Community Centre.
