3D Landscape

We are going to make a 3D landscape using paper shapes!

What you need:

- Paper
- Colouring supplies
- Glue
- Scissors

What to do:

- 1. Choose a landscape idea for your artwork. I decided to do clouds and hot air balloons. To make the 3D cloud you will need 3 or 4 shapes that are symmetrical. To do this fold a piece of paper in half 3 or 4 times. Then draw half of the shape along the folded edge. Have a look at the pictures to help you. Cut the shape out and you will have a few identical pieces.
- 2. To make the 3D cloud fold each shape in half. Glue one half and stick another half to it, so all the edges match up. Do this with all the shapes. It will look like a cloud book where you can turn the pages.
- 3. For my artwork, I made 5 clouds and 2 hot air balloons. Glue everything down onto paper where you have coloured a background.
- 4. Take a photo and show us on the <u>Kids Gallery</u>. What landscape will you make? Think about symmetrical objects like flowers, butterflies, sports balls, buildings, airplanes, cars, the list is endless. Have fun!
