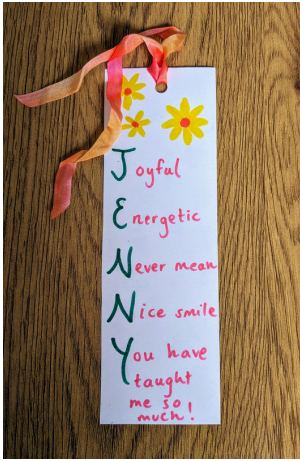


Acrostic Poem Bookmark

A thoughtful gift idea that's easy to make and useful.



What's an acrostic poem?

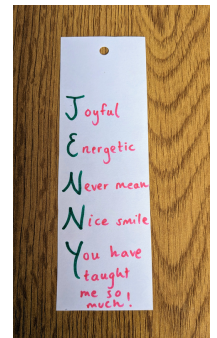
It's a poem where the first letter of each line spells a word or a phrase. The word or phrase can be anything you like.

What you need:

Cardboard, ruler, scissors, textas/pencils
Optional: Hole punch and ribbon

What to do:

- Draw a rectangle onto some cardboard and cut it out.
- Write the letters of a word or phrase down the side of your bookmark. You might want to use the same colour so that it stands out. This bookmark is for a teacher so I've used the teacher's name.
- Think of words or phrases that start with each letter to write your poem. I've used words that describe the teacher.
- Decorate the back of the bookmark. You could draw patterns or pictures of something the person likes.
- If you have a hole punch and a ribbon, you could punch a hole at the top and attach a ribbon.
