MY TWO LOVES

Some of you may know local resident Ayelet Brooks as the ballet teacher from Brooks School of Dance, which runs at the Point Cook Community Learning Centre every Thursday and Saturday. We have the pleasure of Ayelet sharing her artistic journey.

For the past 20 years, since I established my dance school in Point Cook, I have gotten to know hundreds of local families and had the privilege of teaching dance to many children, some of whom are now young adults and some have become teachers at my school.

I was asked about my artistic journey and for this I had to go all the way back to kindergarten. At the age of 4 or 5, I discovered my two loves that were to accompany my life until today - visual art and performing art. Although both have the word 'art' in them, they are nevertheless different from each other in so many ways.

At times I focused more on dance (the prima ballerina dream was real!) and at times life led me more into visual art; painting, printing and sculpture. I have always tended to have an introverted personality and art provided a safe place for me to be in my flow, surrounded by my imagination.

My ballet teacher's husband is a well known artist and he encouraged me to pursue and develop my artistic skills. He was the first to purchase a piece of art that I created as a teenager in art school. It was such an honour! His wife, my beloved ballet teacher, taught me the art of ballet as well as the method of teaching it. Upon completion of my school education I studied graphic design and animation and soon after immigrating to Australia in my early 20's I completed a bachelor degree in fine arts at Monash University.

I am excited to announce and invite you all to my solo exhibition: 'Retrospective' to be held at the Saltwater Community Centre, which opens on 10 April 2024.

"This exhibition showcases a 20 year retrospective of the life of a young couple, capturing moments of their journey from early days of renting a flat to the joys and challenges of raising a family. Each piece tells a story of love, growth and change, inviting viewers to reflect on their own lives within the passage of time."
