Paper Plate Triceratops

What you need:

- Paper plate
- Colour paper
- Scissors
- Glue/sticky tape
- Pencils/textas



What to do:

1. Colour in the plate. This will be the triceratops' face. Draw on eyes at the top of the plate and a mouth on the bottom.



2. Draw and cut out three triangles from paper. These will be the nose and horns.



3.Measure around the plate and draw the frill for the triceratops' head. Cut this out and stick onto the plate.





4.On another piece of paper, measure around the plate again. Now cut this circle in half. This will be the mouth. Stick the half-circle over the mouth you drew on the plate. Draw more sharp teeth!
