India 26% | Philippines 3.2% | New Zealand 2.8%



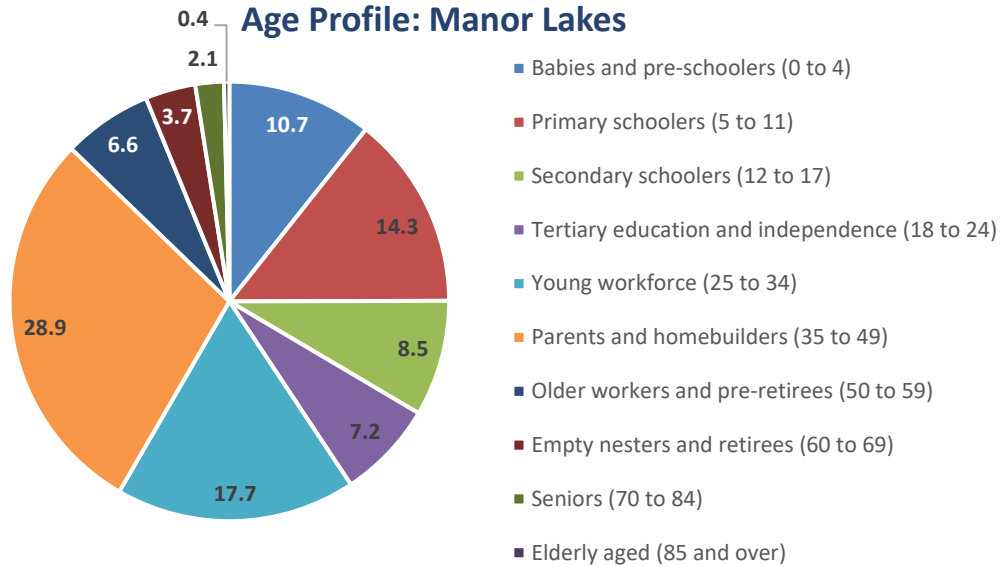
6,131 people living in Manor Lakes in 2021 were employed, of which 67% worked full-time and 26% part-time
