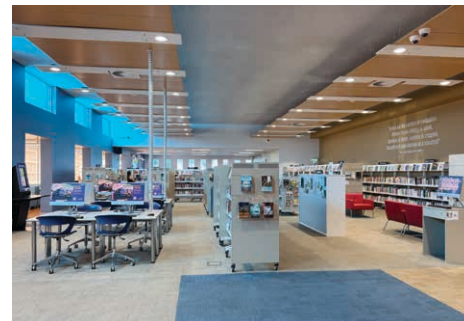


### NAIDOC Week (6–13 July)

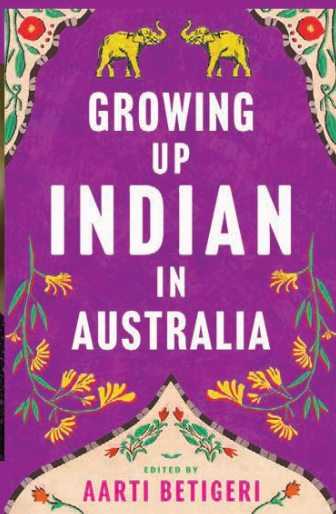

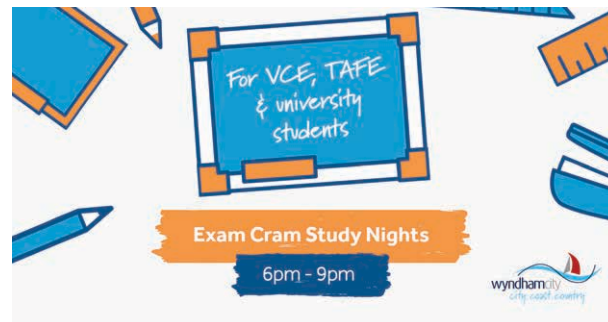

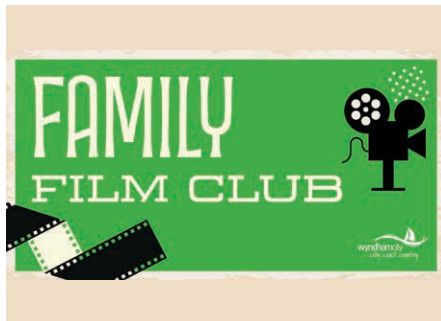
