

Rainbow Paper Towel Experiment

What you need:

- Paper towel
- Water based textas
- Container
- Water



What to do:

1. Using water based markers or textas (permanent markers will not work as well), colour in a rainbow along the bottom edge of the paper towel, about 3cm.
2. Add a little water to a container or bowl and hold the edge you coloured in the water, leaving some of the colour above the water. Watch what happens. The colour will move up the paper towel before your eyes! The ink from the textas spread as the water seeps up the paper towel. The colour will also bleed off the paper towel into the water.
