Rainbow Water Experiment

What you need:

- · Cotton makeup pads
- Water based textas
- Container
- Water





What to do:

- 1. Using water based markers or textas (permanent markers will not work), colour in the cotton make up pad. It can be hard to colour because the cotton pad is soft, so hold the texta on the pad and make a lot of dots to fill up the space.
- 2. Add a little water to a container or bowl and drop the pad into the water. Watch what happens. The colour will bleed off the pad into the water. The more colour you used and the longer the pad is in the water means more colour will bleed off. What colours are more prominent? What happens if you mix the colours?
