## Watercolour Paper





- Watercolour paper or cardstock
- textas
- Spray bottle with water
- Plastic pocket

## What to do:

- 1. Using the textas, colour in a pattern on the plastic pocket. Because the plastic is shiny, the textas will not dry and the ink will stay damp.
- 2. Spray a little water on to the plastic pocket. Press the paper on top and smooth it with your hands. The ink will transfer from the plastic onto the paper.
- 3. Leave the paper to dry. You could turn your design into a card, bookmarks, or add more detail on it with a pen.
- 4. What different designs can you make? What happens when you mix colours together?
