
## HANGING PAPER FLOWER

## What you need:


- Paper in 3 different colours
- Ribbon
- Scissors
- Sticky tape /glue
- Stapler
- Ruler





## What to do:

- 1. Measure and cut the following:
  - a.8 red strips of paper 3cm x 21cm
  - b.8 orange strips 3cm x 16cm
  - c.8 yellow strips 3cm x 11cm
- 2. Line one of each colour up like in the picture: red with orange on top, then yellow on top.
- 3. Bend the paper strips into a curved petal shape like in the picture. Staple them together at the end.













- 4. Repeat this 8 times, so you have 8 petals.
- 5. Join 2 petals together using some glue or tape on the stapled end. Do this 4 times so 4 of the petals are joined together. Repeat this with the other 4 petals.







6. Join the two sides of the flower together. Then tie the ribbon on in a loop so you can hang the flower up.

You could make a few flowers and have them all hanging together.
