


# Watercolour sunset

## What you need:

- Watercolour paper
- Watercolour paints
- Paint brush
- Masking tape
- Optional- Gold marker

## What to do:

1. I like to use masking tape to stick the edges of the paper down onto my table. The tape will give the painting a border when finished.
2. Start by painting the ocean, on the bottom third of the paper. Use dark blue paint on the horizon line, making the colour lighter as you near the end of the paper. Blend dark blue and light blue paint together as you paint the ocean water.



3. Paint a yellow half circle above the water. This is the sun. While the paint is still wet, add a little orange to one side of the sun.

Using a clean brush and water, wet the area of paper for the sky. Use a mix of purple and pink paints to colour the sunset sky. Add in orange around the sun. Use a wet brush to blend the colours together.



4. Leave the painting to dry for a few hours. If you have a gold marker, you can add details to the sun and the ocean, so it looks like the sunlight is reflecting on the water.

5. Remove the tape from the edges of the paper and it is finished!
