Cats and dogs aged three months and older must be registered



Cats must be microchipped and desexed



Dogs must be microchipped, unless you have an exemption from your vet



First time registration is free. Your renewal fee is due by April 10 each year

Use this form to register:

- a new pet
- a pet that has moved into Wyndham from another municipality.

You can register up to three pets on this form. If you have more than one pet, you may also need to apply for an excess animal permit. To find out more, visit our website and search for 'animal permits'.

What you need

- Your pet's microchip number.
- Certificate of desexing from your vet.
- If eligible, your Centrelink or DVA concession.
- If applicable, evidence that your pet is exempt from desexing.

Registration tag

Once we process your application, we will send you a registration tag. This must be always worn by your pet.

If you lose or damage your tag, we charge a \$5 fee for a replacement tag.

*A dog that is kept for the purpose of guarding non-residential premises is automatically a dangerous dog under the Domestic Animals Act 1994. Once a dog is deemed a dangerous dog it cannot be revoked - the dog is a dangerous dog for life, even if it ceases to be used for the purpose of guarding non-residential premises.
