

Apply for an excess animal permit

About this form

You need an excess animal permit if you live in a residential property and have more than:

- 2 dogs
- 3 cats
- 2 dogs and 2 cats
- 1 dog and 3 cats
- 1 dog and 1 cat in a flat or unit
- 10 domestic birds
- 6 chickens or other poultry
- 10 pigeons
- 4 rabbits, guinea pigs and ferrets.

You also need permit if you have a loud bird like a cockatoo, galah or parrot.

If you live on a rural property, you need a permit if you have more than:

- 4 dogs
- 4 cats.

You must register your pets before you apply for an excess animal permit.

What you need

- Your animals' details, including the registration number for cats and dogs.
- A plan of your property showing where the animals are kept and housed. This can be hand drawn. There is a space to draw your plan on the last page of this form.
